Questions to Ask Your Doctor about Mediastinal Tumors

- 1. Will my condition ever get better without treatment? Can it get worse?
- 2. Where is my mediastinal tumor located?
- 3. Is it cancerous? If yes, what is the survival rate for my particular kind of cancer?
- 4. What are my treatment options?
- 5. What are the potential side effects of this treatment?
- 6. How often do you perform the procedure that you've recommended for me?
- 7. What is the success rate for that specific procedure?
- 8. Are there any lifestyle changes I can make now?
- 9. When should I seek medical attention if I am experiencing symptoms following treatment?
- 10. Will I have any restrictions after treatment? (activity, driving, etc)
- 11. How long will I be out of work?
- 12. Will I have to change my diet and/or lifestyle after treatment?
- 13. Will I have to take any long-term medications?
- 14. How likely is it that I will need additional treatment later?
- 15. Are there any clinical trials relevant to my cancer?
- 16. If I want a second opinion, how would I get one?
